
Making its official debut in 2023, *Jump Cut* is suitable for all ages, languages and imaginations and can be enjoyed from 360°.

The Company:

In 2011, professional circus artists, Raphael Herault (FR) and Summer Hubbard (USA), met while working as acrobats for the company *Cirque du Soleil*.

While working there, the pair discovered their mutual love for cinema and soon thereafter discovered the existence of some interesting and untapped potential for circus within the world of cinema as well as cinema within the world of circus.

Riding on the heels of this exciting discovery, Summer and Raphael branched out on their own and created the company *Double Take - Cinematic Circus*.

Established and currently based in Belgium, the company is driven by the exploration of circus and cinema and the nature in which these two arts may be exploited, linked, adapted, and transposed.

For example, for the last several years Summer and Raphael used their knowledge as circus acrobats to create a wide-range of circus films and inversely when they used their knowledge as filmmakers to create the original, 45-minute show, *Jump Cut*.
